- 1989** – Stonewall established
 - 1992** – WHO declassifies homosexuality as mental illness
 - 1997** – Openly gay MPs
 - 2000** – Military ban overturned
 - 2001** – Age of consent equalised
 - 2001** – Stonewall Scotland
 - 2003** – Section 28 repealed (England & Wales)
 - 2003** – Stonewall Cymru
 - 2003, 2006** – Equality legislation
 - 2007** – Some People Are Gay, Get Over It!
 - 2013** – Equal marriage
 - 2014** – Stonewall starts to incorporate trans issues
