

# Record of decision taken under delegated authority by a Council officer

## Summary

This is to approve £2,684 of Public Realm capital to fund the installation of a moped barrier in Watermead Lane.

Residents and Councillors feel that it is important to ensure the safety of people using this area. There are residential cottages along Watermead Lane and the mopeds use it as a cut through into the park, creating a noise nuisance, often at night. This also poses a risk for families walking this route.

Currently the Local Committee has a budget of £55,671, this is made up of £32,664 Public Realm capital, £0 Local Transport Fund and £23,007 revenue funding.

If awarded, the Local Committee will have a budget of £52,987, made up of £29,980 Public Realm capital, £0 Local Transport Fund and £23,007 revenue funding.

## Decision


### That:

1. £2,684 of Public Realm capital be approved to fund the installation of a moped barrier in Watermead Lane.

Reasons for Decision: The moped barrier will stop moped users using this road as a cut through to the park, stop noise nuisance to the cottages along Watermead Lane and ensure improved safety for people walking along this route.
