“Improving Local Committees”

- More community groups could present at Local Committees to enable them to inform people what their groups do and how people can engage with local community groups.
- People felt that the agendas were too long and not interesting for residents.
- There was a suggestion of the agenda being sent out sooner so people could comment on it or inform people in advance what was on the agenda, so they had a chance to submit questions on topics they are interested in.
- Highways updates should only come to Local Committee once a year.
- Charities should be able to present at Local Committee, like the Rotary Club, to inform residents on local projects and ways they can help the community.
- Question time is too short and should be at start of meeting.

“Improving Local Committees”

- **Agenda: allow possibility for Community Reps to request an agenda topic or two via email to LLO, after the previous meeting. Final decision still to rests with Chair.**
- **Public Question Time: Written question first and hopefully answer before the meeting where possible. Then onto questions from the floor and ensure questions are relevant and not a statement. “Control those that want to ramble on”. Councillors to answer where possible or send answer after the meeting.**
- **Start meeting at 7pm and ensure it is finished by 930pm.**
