Dear Sir,

Further to your letter dated 4th July 2018 I am writing to you, objecting to the above tree preservation order on the following grounds.

- They cause a significant amount of unwelcome shade on our property and garden year round.
- Drop fir cones and needles all over the front and back of our property and garden.
- Wind pollinated particularly in the spring, which is a potential asthma irritant.
- In view of their age and height the trees in question are potentially approaching a state of significant hazard in stormy weather, which could occasion the falling of tree limbs that could injure pedestrians and damage property, including cars. A considerable amount of the limbs are already drooping.

The trees in question do not enhance either myself or my son's lives.
