Summary

On 30 June 2015, the Beddington and Wallington Local Committee decided to delegate the authority to take the decision on Neighbourhood Grants to the Strategic Director of Environment, Housing and Regeneration, in consultation with the Chair, Vice Chair and the appropriate ward councillors for the application.

Wandle Side Residents' Association have applied for a neighbourhood grant of £270 to go towards food, printing, prizes, decorations and entertainment for their winter street party event, which is taking place on 8 December 2018 in Wallington North. The event will help to promote community spirit in the Wandle Side area.

There is currently £902 available in the Neighbourhood Grants budget for Beddington and Wallington. If the application is successful, there would be £632 remaining in the budget for this area.

Decision

That:


1. Wandle Side Residents Association receive a Neighbourhood Grant of £270 to go towards food, printing, prizes, decorations and entertainment for their winter street party event.
