**Summary**

To approve the following project from the St Helier, The Wrythe and Wandle Valley public realm budget for festive lights for all wards within the Local Committee area as listed below:

**Festive Lights:**

- Wrythe Green Road- 5 units
- Green Wrythe Lane - 5 units
- Rosehill - 10 units
- Middleton Circle - 9 units
- Hackbridge -10 units including pole fixings
- St Helier - 3 x tree lights
- Across Committee area - installation and removal of lights and TfL application fee.

This is an ongoing annual commitment for the local committee with three years remaining of the current five-year contract.

Total: £25,706 public realm capital converted to revenue

The Local Committee currently have £71,489 made up of £4,173 Public Realm Revenue, £49,569 Public Realm Capital and £17,747 LtF Funding.

Once approved the remaining budget will be £45,783, made up of £4,173 Public Realm Revenue, £23,863 Public Realm Capital and £17,747 LtF funding.

**Decision**

**That:**

1. The sum of £25,706 public realm capital converted to revenue for supplying and installing festive lights.


Reasons for Decision: To enable the festive lights to be installed as listed above.

These were both rejected by Councillors as feedback from residents suggested festive lights are important to them and their local area and therefore, they wanted to keep the number and locations the same as last year as per the existing contract.
