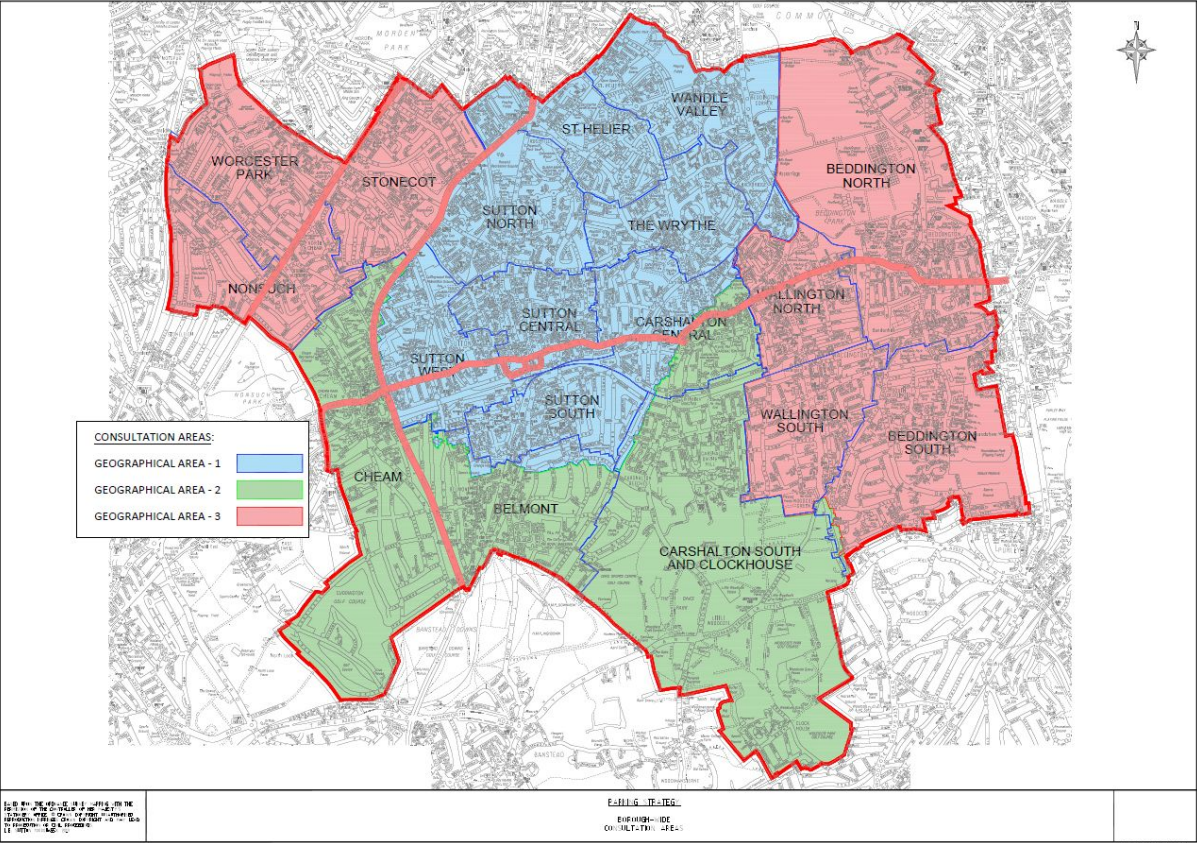

Parking Strategy - Geographical Area 3 (GA3)



Parking Strategy - Background

The parking strategy was agreed in 2016 and set out the mandate to carry out a large scale consultation with members of the public to better understand the parking pressures in the borough and to use the information gathered from the public to design schemes to improve parking for the residents of Sutton.

There were 2 informal stages of consultation. The informal Stage 2 consultation ran from 2 March 20 until 3 May 20, which included an extension period due to Covid-19, and to ensure residents had ample time to respond to the survey. The full results of the survey have been reviewed.

The results received in that initial period were in line with other consultations

Parking Strategy - What the consultation told us

From a review of the stage 2 informal consultation, it was decided that the council proposed not to proceed with the following at the present time:

Ross Road Area - Free bay scheme (Wallington South Ward)

The council will however proceed with area-wide, small-scale waiting restrictions (yellow lines) where required for safety reasons, and these are primarily at road junctions. This includes Hinton Road - 2 wheel footway parking bays to improve access

Parking Strategy - Next Steps

Current timeline for Geographical Area 3 -

December 2020 - Meetings held with Ward Councillors to discuss proposals

January/February 2021 - Draft the traffic orders for the GA3 area

February/March 2021 - Statutory TMO Consultation to run for 21 days, between the 25th of February to 18th March, legal notice will be placed in the paper as well as site notices

Parking Strategy - Next Steps (continued)

Current timeline for Geographical Area 3 -

March/April - Analysis/Review of consultation

April 2021 - Further meetings with Ward Councillors to discuss results of statutory consultation and decide way forward

June/July 2021 - Implementation of changes
