## Where does it comes from?

- Neighbourhood portion of **Community Infrastructure Levy** - collected on new development within the borough

## What can we fund?

- Infrastructure projects that help address the **demands that development places on an area**
- E.g. community hall refurbishment, new play equipment, recycling bins

## How do we allocate?

- Bidding round for eligible council-led and external projects followed by a public consultation
- Assessing projects against consultation response and other criteria

# 2020 Projects allocated funding: St Helier, The Wrythe and Wandle Valley

- Trial smart waste measures for apartments at Mill Green, Culvers Retreat, Denmark Gardens
- Install rain garden and sustainable drainage at Wandle Valley Academy and Victor Seymour Infants School
- Refurbish fences along River Wandle by Watercress Park
- Replacement steel fencing at Poulter park

From other infrastructure funding:

- St Helier Open Space - covered bins, repaint skate ramps, remark ball courts
- New playground equipment at Orchard Avenue Rec
- Relandscape Middleton Circus Roundabout
