

Beddington and Wallington Statistics

All statistics based on a rolling 12 months compared to the previous rolling 12 months.

Total Notifiable Offences (TNO)

Beddington South

717 offences, a reduction of 55 on the previous rolling 12 months
6th highest crime of 18 wards

Beddington North

697 offences a reduction of 84 on the previous rolling 12 months
8th highest crime of 18 wards

Wallington South

746 offences a reduction of 72 on the previous rolling 12 months
5th highest crime of 18 wards

Wallington North

712 offences a reduction of 119 on the previous rolling 12 months
7th highest crime of 18 wards

Burglary: Wallington North has had an increase whereas the other three wards have all had a decrease. Beddington North has had a decrease of 76 with only 37 offences.

Robbery: Wallington South is the highest of the four with 18 offences, 10 down on the previous rolling 12 months. Robbery offences remain very low across the borough.

Violence against the person: All wards have had significant decreases.

Weapons: Wallington South the lowest in the borough with one offence and Wallington North the highest of the four but with just 7 offences.

Ward Panels : There is reinvigorated drive to ensure all ward panels are active and have chairpersons. Where there isn't a ward panel officers have been tasked with finding interested parties and setting dates.

Dates for ward panels are now to be set one year in advance and the default position is for the panels to be held virtually. This may be the case even once the current COVID restrictions have been lifted.
